**SSNMC CONCERNS ON THE MISTREATMENT OF ITS CHAIRPERSON, HON.
MORO ISAAC JENESIO BY THE LEADERSHIP OF CENTRAL EQUATORIA
STATE.**

The Leadership of South Sudan National Movement for Change (SSNMC) is disturbed and concerned with the continued mistreatment and humiliation of its Chairperson, Hon. Moro Isaac Jenesio, the Minister of Local Government and Law Enforcement Agencies by the Governor of Central Equatoria State.

It must be noted that prior to his appointment as a Minister of Local Government and Law Enforcement Agencies, Hon. Moro has served competently and diligently as the head of Secretariat for Joint Military Ceasefire Commission, which was tasked with cantonment, registration, screening and unification of all forces to the Agreement in Republic of South Sudan during the pre-transitional period. His proven expertise in administration, competence, commitment, and determination for service delivery to this Nation and peace is visible to every South Sudanese and those that have good will for this Country. His successful efforts to help stabilize security and improve on the performance of Local Governance in Central Equatoria State and Juba City, have drawn upon him unrealistic hatred expressed through disarmament of his role as a Minister of Local Government, threats and intimidations of removal from his position because the public is recognitive and appreciative of his efforts of goodwill for this Country.

For the last two years, Hon. Moro Isaac Jenesio has gone through a challenging moment amidst series of framed charges against him by the Governor, intimidations, and several unwarranted requests of removal through the office of Vice-President, H.E Hussein Abdelbagi Akol. It must also be noted that, Hon. Moro Isaac Jenesio did not only face uncollaborative administrative challenges, but also life-threatening situations including surviving several rebel ambushes while on Government missions. On several occasions, he suffered restriction from moving to the Counties he supervises, while his role is assigned to some State Advisors and Ministers contrary to the Local government Act 2009.

We have again reliably been informed about the Governor's renewed demand for H.E Vice President of the Republic and chair of service cluster to yield to his demand of removal of our Chairperson. As a constituent member of SSOA, we are concerned and feel that this persistent determination to undermine opposition leaders is completely against the spirit of the Agreement that requires friendly working relationship amongst the peace partners.

We therefore, appeal to the Leadership of SSOA to intervene and resolve this unending victimization of our leader once and for all. We reiterate our unquestionable and unwavering commitment to the implementation of R-ARCSS 2018 in letter and spirit.
